

WHAT IS ENTREPRENEURSHIP? THEORY & HISTORY

- E = f (e): [entrepreneurship (E) is a function of entrepreneurs (e)]
 - The starting point of any entrepreneurial process is the entrepreneur
 - Entrepreneurship derived from French entreprendre (to undertake) implies role of go-between
- Definition: Typically, entrepreneurship involves:
 - Idea creation, Opportunity recognition, Achievement orientation, Risk taking, Resourcefulness

- Schumpeter launched the field of entrepreneurship
 - associating entrepreneurs with innovation and creative destruction (making old technology obsolete)

Technopreneurs

 Entrepreneurs in technology e.g Zuckerberg (Facebook), Bill Gates (Microsoft), Steve Jobs (Apple)

Intrapreneurs or Corporate Entrepreneurs

 Entrepreneurs in organisation, used to reinvigorate organisations – a turn around strategy, common in developed countries

Social Entrepreneurs

- Grown out of the need for more social innovation as well as dwindling donor funding, driven by making a difference not necessary to be wealthy
- They are not necessarily charity, NGO or philanthropist

• Global Entrepreneurs

This is the key, this is my hope and what inspire me, that we will all grow to be Global,
 Afropreneurs. E.g from trends in US, tenderpreneur dilemma

CRUEL REALITY ABOUT ENTREPRENEURSHIP

- A variety of studies has shown that 70-90% of start up business die in the 1st 3years, and those that survive the 1st 3years within 5 to 10 years
- Start-ups are known to kill or destroy the people who start them, after few years they don't want anything to do with them but a job
- They are burnout, lost confidence, loss money and in debts
- The are variety of factors that lead to start-up failures, don't want to waste time on them rather focus on the solution
 - Lack of Entrepreneurship & Financial management skills
 - Lack of funding, lack of systems
 - Lack of government support, red tapes
